Convention Update



The Convention is fast approaching and we have been working to finalize all the details. At the last Governors Meeting we talked about doing “touring” laps at the Motorsports Park Track one day. We have all the details in place to do this on Wednesday, August 24th. We will have a morning and afternoon session and the cost will be \$40.00 per driver.

“Touring Laps” will consist of at least one session of the entire motorsports track and depending on how well the participants behave we hope to have multiple runs available in the morning and afternoon groups. The “touring laps” consist of groups of 4 or 5 cars, led by a track employee around the course at a moderate speed for at least (2) laps per run. Pre-registration will be required for scheduling purposes and this information will be available on the NCCC Web Site under the 2017 Convention Section.
