Since inception, NCCC's purpose has been and still is to promote interest in Corvette ownership and operation, to publish information on the use and operation of the Corvette and to establish an organized effort to encourage others to participate in the



enjoyment connected with the use and ownership of America's Sports Car – the Corvette!

As an individual or Corvette Club, you might ask, "What's in it for us, why should we become a member of NCCC?" • NCCC is an organization with a focus on charities and grants, which began in 1975 and has grown steadily, not only in dollar amounts given but also in the area of service.

Since 1975, NCCC has donated over \$1.5 million to the *Muscular Dystrophy Association, the Spina Bifida Association of America, the National Kidney Foundation and*

now St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Funds for St. Jude are raised with a raffle providing the winner a certificate to purchase a new Corvette. Under the **grants division**, we have provisions for member hardships.

competition events which include concours d'elegance (car shows), drag racing, economy run, funkhana, rallye, speed events (high and low) along with time trials.


