From the Secretary

Governors' Meeting Minutes – August 9, 2009 Abridged for *Blue Bars* Publication

Dick asked that we also remember those serving in the armed forces in our thoughts and prayers.

Dick introduced Joan Thomas and acknowledged her and her committee for all the hard work setting up the historical displays set up around the room. Debbie Lindsey introduced the sponsors who were present. And acknowledged them for all the various ways in which they support us. Judy Vajda of Hagerty Insurance and Mike Yager of Mid-America Motorworks gave brief presentations.

Officers Reports:

Cindy Urenda – Secretary

There were no corrections to the minutes from May. The minutes were approved as printed.

Kevin Milton - Parliamentarian

The REs did not have a meeting. They will be reading two By-law changes at the September meeting.

Jack Wilson – VP of Competition

There were no clarifications at the RCD meeting. 9 of 16 items for the new rulebook were discussed. The other 7 will be discussed at their September meeting and will be presented at the September Governors' meeting.

There were three decisions made that are effective immediately:

1. Record Drags on the NCCC Web is now listed with Men on one side and Ladies on the other. New records will be highlighted.
2. The top of the new tech form will be changed. It said entrant/NCCC number, and over 60% of people wrote in their number without their name. It will be broken into name, number, class and car number.
3. The 2010 Grandsport will go into M class. There will not be interchangeability issues in this class. This is the best fit based on its specs. It is possible that once we get experience on this class it will have to be moved. We don't know at this point.

How a Charter Member Became a Member of N.C.C.C.

Happy 50th Anniversary to all.

50 YEARS...WOW!!! Father Time has gone by so quickly.

It's hard to believe that it has been 50 years since I went into Gates Chevrolet in South Bend, IN one Friday night in March. I went there to purchase a new Chevrolet Impala Convertible. I had put the deal together for a new Chevy Impala and was waiting to see the Finance Manager to sign the paper work and drive home my new Impala Convertible. As I was wandering around the showroom floor, I came across a Corvette.

Little did I know that what was about to take place would introduce me to a whole new group of people. Many of these people would become friends and, for some, my very best and life long friends. My life, my thinking and my ambitions were about to take a 180-degree turn and I would become a totally different person. (For the best, I might add.)

I was sitting in the driver's seat of a 230HP, 3-speed, Corvette with AM-FM Radio, Whitewall Tires, a Convertible Top and a Hard Top when Bob Ruth, the Sales Manager for Gates Chevrolet walked by. He said to me, "You Know, Terry, you should be purchasing this Corvette instead of that Impala. We have a Corvette Club that is sponsored by Gates Chevrolet. I think you would enjoy being a member of our club. We have monthly meetings, run rallies, have speed events that will test your skill as a driver. We drive in parades, have a lot of parties and sometimes just go for a drive and have dinner. Let me get the keys and take you for a ride."

The next thing I knew we were driving this Corvette in a manner that scared the "you know what out of me." Yes!! Even in a 230HP Corvette. I was used to driving a 6-cylinder Chevy Bel Air Power Glide. (For you Youngsters, a Power Glide is a 2-speed automatic transmission.) We always called them "slush-amatics."

To this day, I will never be sure whether Bob Ruth was trying to impress me with his driving skills (which were very good) or actually showing me the performance a Corvette was capable of.

When we got back to the dealership, he handed me the keys and said. "Here you take it home and drive it for the weekend. Here is my address, bring it to my house Sunday evening and let me know what you decide to do. If you are concerned about the cost, I will sell it to you for 20% off the sticker price and you pay us \$100 for our profit." (Bob Ruth!! I hope you don't get into trouble with your old boss, Van Gates, for me telling everyone about this Corvette sale. I am quite sure you did not sell many, if any, other Corvettes this way.)

Can you imagine today a dealership giving a 21-year-old kid the keys to a brand new Corvette and telling him to go have fun for a weekend???

It would never happen. And I will never know why it happened to me. Needless to say, I had a "Great Time" that weekend driving a brand new Corvette and Sunday evening came around way too fast.

I took the Corvette to Bob Ruth's house on Sunday evening and rang the door bell. Bob came to the door with only one sales contract in his hand and said, "Sign here on the bottom line". He knew he would never get those keys back.

So I became a member of the Michiana Corvette Club in South Bend, IN. The Michiana Corvette Club was one of the first Corvette clubs in the United States formed in 1957 and listed in *Corvette News*. One day we received a letter to see if the members of Michiana Corvette Club would be interested in helping to form a National Corvette Association. Our membership thought it would be a great idea to have a National Organization. So, in 1960 our club was represented at the first meeting in Detroit, MI and became one of the first members of National Council of Corvette Clubs. Fred Goss became Michiana's first Governor.

When the Charter Members were recognized in 1974, five of our Charter Members were still active. They were: Fred Goss, now deceased; Van Gates, owner of Gates Chevrolet in South Bend, IN, Bob Ruth, Gene Lewis (whom later moved to Virginia and became a member of the Corvette Club of America and me, Terry Tetzlaff.

Point of reference: Back in those days, many people got the Michiana Corvette Club confused with the Corvette Club of Michigan. Many old records will show Michigan Corvette Club after one of Michiana's member's name, including mine.

In 2007, the Southeast Region lost one of its biggest contributors, Sue McGee. Sue left a legacy within the Region that spanned over 15 years as the Regional Membership Director. During her tenure, the Region's membership doubled to over 950!

As the Region prepared to fund its first Sue McGee scholarship grant at the 50th NCCC Convention – we were thrilled to learn that one of our own Southeast Region members might be in the running for a scholarship. When the scholarships were announced, we were extremely pleased to learn that CURRIE BROWN (a member of Valley Vettes – Huntsville, AL and pre-Law major at the University of Alabama – which met both of Sue's criteria!!) was the first recipient. To make the selection even more special – Sue always encouraged Currie to drive faster in order to beat her dad!! We believe in divine intervention – who would buck Sue??!

We asked Currie to share her thoughts of receiving this scholarship and here is her story:

I am beyond honored to be awarded the first Sue McGee scholarship for the Southeast Region! This scholarship is such an asset to my education. Right now, I am attending the University of Alabama and studying criminal justice. Fall semester just started and I am already busy, busy, busy! This is only my second year at the university, but I am already classified as a junior. School is definitely a top priority for me, and I pride myself on making straight A's. I also have a presidential scholarship from the University based on my academic record and community involvement. I hope to attend the University of Alabama Law School once I finish my undergraduate studies.

I have been in love with Corvettes since the day my dad introduced me to our first 1970 Montana Red Stingray. Before I was even able to legally drive, I knew that one day my only car would be a Corvette. My dad used to let me drive around the block with him every now and then in that car, but it wasn't until I was 16 that we got our next Corvette, a red 1981. This car quickly became the only car I wanted to drive. My dad also purchased a 2004 Commemorative Edition a year earlier, but I have yet to be behind the wheel of that car! I was so enthusiastic about Corvettes and driving fast that a member of our club, Valley Vettes, and, basically my racing mentor, Zeke Jenkins, introduced me to autocross events. I was instantly hooked and participated in as many events as I could over the next few years. Unfortunately, it has been hard for me to make it home from college for many events now, but as soon as I get settled down in life, I know I will return to autocrossing. I was one of the youngest people in the Southeast Region to earn a high speed license, and I plan on maintaining that status when I get older!

In my many years of autocrossing and participating in Corvette club events, I have had the honor of meeting Sue and John McGee. They, like every Corvette owner I have met over the years, are truly wonderful people. One of my fondest memories is after a day of autocrossing. The events had just finished for the weekend, and I was on the Interstate headed home. Out of nowhere, probably due to the heat from racing and from driving on the Interstate, one of my tires blew out. I was in between two 18 wheeler trucks, but I managed to navigate safely to the edge of the highway. I called my dad in a complete panic at what had just happened. Before he could even make it to me, four or five other Corvette drivers on their way home from the event had stopped on the side of the road with me. By the time it was over and done with, around 10 Corvettes had stopped when they saw me. The line of Corvettes down the highway was an awesomely reassuring and inspiring event.

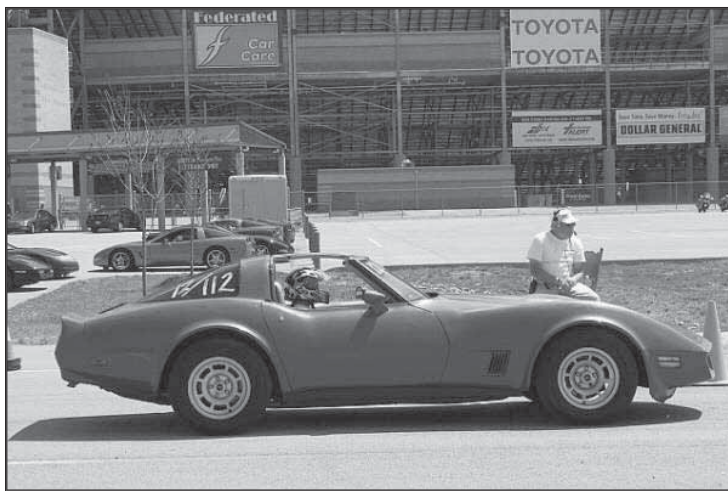

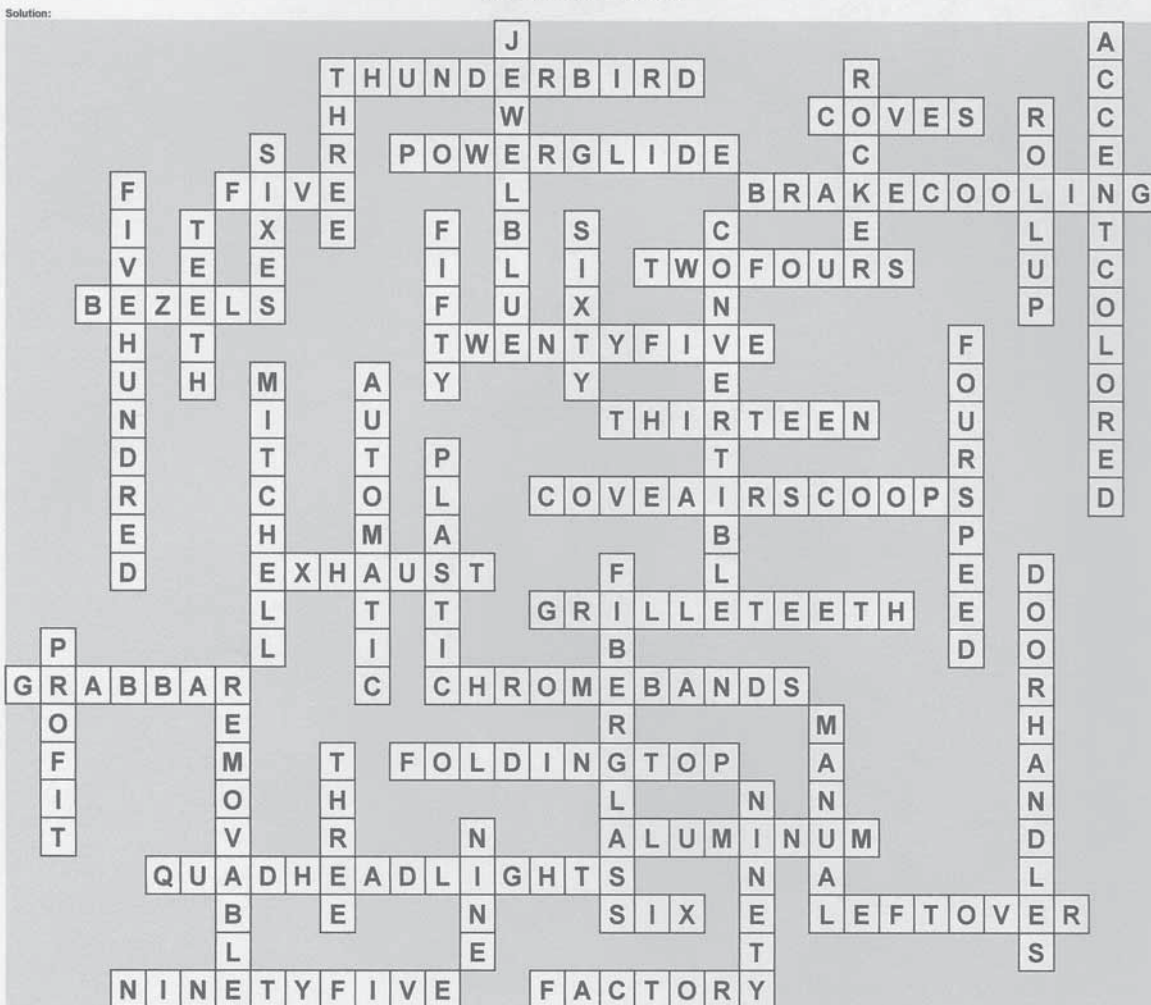

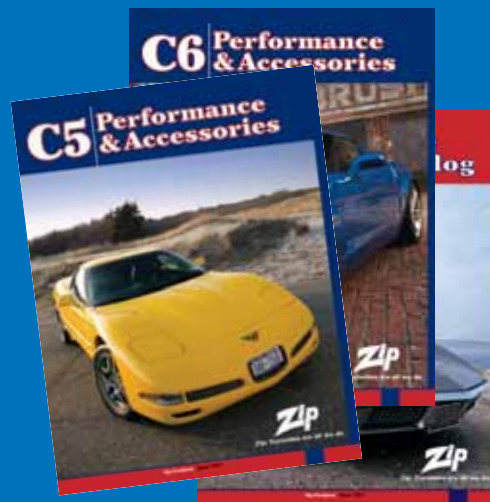
