

## 2013 Rulebook Clarifications

### 2/22/2013 Meeting

- a) **Clarification Number:** 2013\_01
- **Rulebook Page:** 1-5, 2-6
  - **Rulebook Section:** 1.7.1.1, 2.2.8.2
  - **Clarification Requested:** Confirmation of the minimum age for passengers in low speed autocross events. Rulebook refers to two different sections on this which can be confusing.
  - **Competition Committee Clarification:** Per Rulebook Section 2.2.8, item 2: Passengers must meet the competition eligibility requirements of Section 1.7.1 of the NCCC Rule Book. Section 1.7.1, items 1 and 2 are as follows:
    1. All drivers **MUST** be at least sixteen (16) years old, carry and present at registration a currently valid driver's license to operate an automobile on the public streets. Any license or permit which requires another licensed driver in the car is not acceptable. Drivers younger than eighteen (18) years old may not enter High Speed Events. Drivers eighteen (18) years and older **MUST** be High Speed Certified to enter High Speed Events.
    2. Navigators in Rallye and Economy Run Events **MUST** be at least nine (9) years old. Navigators in Funkhana Events **MUST** meet the eligibility requirements to compete as per the NCCC Rulebook Section 1.7.1. item 1 (same as driver).

*Therefore, the committee clarifies that the minimum passenger ages are:*

- Low Speed Autocross: 16 with a valid driver's license
- Rallye (Navigator): 9
- Funkhana, (Navigator): 16
- No Passengers in High Speed events under any circumstances
